---

Local sugarcane spirit infused with island botanicals,  
sea-mineral vermouth, homemade tropical cordial



Here we celebrate Quarrel, a character in Ian Fleming's famous spy novels and short stories.

Quarrel was a Caymanian fisherman and master of the seas, who took a young James Bond under his wing and taught him the ways of the ocean. The Caribbean was a massive influence on Fleming, who wrote most of his books in Jamaica and set numerous stories amongst the people and places of the islands.

*“Hey Quarrel, if you see a dragon, you get in first and breathe on him. With all that rum in you, he’ll die happy.”*

# WHITE ANGEL 18

---

Cacao Tito's vodka, saffron Bombay Sapphire gin,  
aperitif cordial, wine, sparkles



Holly Golightly has become, in no small part due to the film, an iconic symbol who personifies cosmopolitan chic and quaint scattiness, such as burning chicken and saffron in chocolate sauce, and living her life exactly as she wishes – Which was a pretty scandalous proposition at the time.

Joe, her favourite bartender mixes her a special drink, equal parts vodka and gin and calls it a White Angel, which we have (go)lightly elevated with a Tiffany's sense of luxury.

*“Reading dreams. That’s what started her walking down the road. Every day she’d walk a little further: a mile, and come home. Two miles, and come home. One day she just kept on.”*

# NEVERMORE 18

---

Pink peppercorn and dark chocolate infused 1840 Pierre Ferrand Cognac, citrus oils, demerara, absinthe, bitters



A quiet night, yet constant rapping, deep in thought until mindless tapping, there must be someone at his door? A distraught lover sits at home mourning the loss of his beloved – Lenore.

Upon opening the door he finds only a raven, who takes position above his fireplace and can seemingly speak but a single word. Unclear whether the man is really talking to himself or the raven, this short story slowly traces his descent into madness.

Edgar Allen Poe famously drank Cognac and absinthe, often together, as they are here. Master American poet known for his short stories that circle around mystery, the supernatural and the macabre.

*“And his eyes have all the seeming of a demon’s that is dreaming  
And the lamp-light o’er him streaming throws his shadow on the floor  
And my soul from out that shadow that lies floating on the floor  
Shall be lifted - nevermore!”*

# HENRY'S STASH 16

---

Peach-infused Old Forester bourbon, magnolia, lemon,  
assam tea, orange, maple, milk clarified



Alice Walker is a prolific American writer and social activist, best known for her Pulitzer Prize winning novel *The Color Purple*.

A daughter visits her family home in a poor and rural area of Georgia after being away for several years. She has changed her name, is now living in the city and heavily involved in the Black Power movement of the late 1960's.

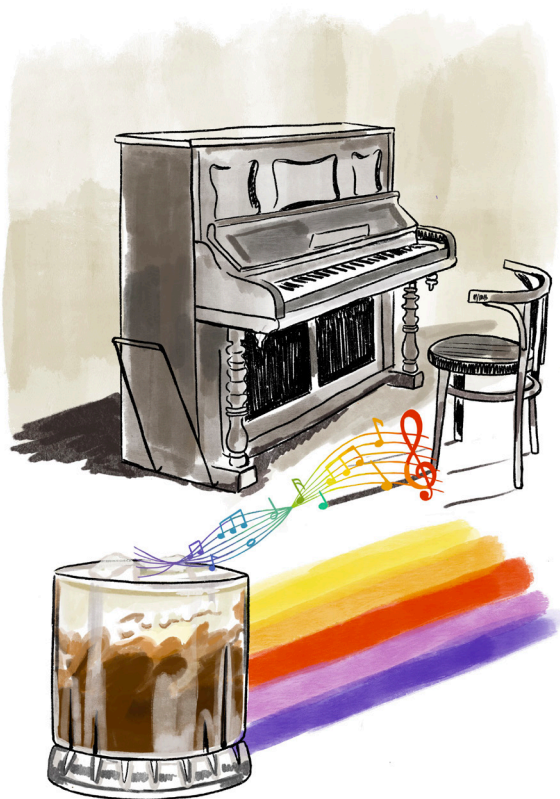
Over the course of their lunch, Wangero demands several items from her mother, including a milk churner, and some old handmade quilts made by her grandmother. She wants to use them as display pieces and talking points at her home in the city, whereas at her family home they are simply items of everyday use, and her mother wishes them to remain so, and gives them to her younger daughter Maggie for that purpose.

*“Aunt Dee’s first husband whittled the dash,” said Maggie, so low you almost couldn’t hear her. His name was Henry, but they called him Stash.”*

## SINGIN' & SWINGIN' 19

---

Hickory smoked rum blend, chicory coffee,  
spiced buttercream caramel foam



Dr. Maya Angelou was a writer, poet, dancer, singer, scholar and civil rights activist.

Singin' & Swingin' is taken from her third autobiography written about her twenties, and describes as she develops her musical career, touring throughout the US and Europe, and her feelings about leaving her son behind. Her original style of writing mirrored her award winning poetry.

Taking influences from the music, food and characters of the story, this drink also brings together some of the favourite flavours of this remarkable woman.

*"Music was my refuge. I could crawl into the spaces between the notes and curl my back to loneliness.*

*In my rented room (cooking privileges down the hall), I would play a record, then put my arms around the shoulder of the song.*

*As we danced, glued together, I would nuzzle into its neck, kissing the skin, and rubbing its cheek with my own."*

# WINDMILLS CALLING 18

---

Lime leaf Tanqueray Flor de Sevilla gin, homemade  
rhubarb & ginger cordial, lemon, sparkling wine



A call to adventure - the plot of *Don Quixote* by Cervantes revolves around the adventures of a low nobleman named Alonso Quijano, who has either lost or pretends to have lost his mind after reading so many chivalric romances, that he appoints himself a knight with the mission of reviving chivalry and serving his nation.

He recruits a simple farmer, Sancho Panza, as his squire, who often employs a unique, earthy wit and realism in contrast to his master's idealism. In the first part of the book, Don Quixote does not see the world for what it is, and prefers to imagine that he is living out a knightly story.

*“The scariest dragons and the fiercest giants usually  
turn out to be no more than windmills.”*

# ALMOND BLOSSOM 17

---

Sunflower seed genever, yellow Chartreuse,  
maraschino, lemon, orgeat, egg white



‘Almond Blossoms’ is a group of several paintings made from 1888-1890 by Vincent van Gogh in Arles and Saint-Rémy, southern France of blossoming almond trees.

Flowering trees were special to van Gogh. They represented awakening and hope. He enjoyed them aesthetically and found joy in painting flowering trees; they inspired him greatly.

Van Gogh borrowed the subject, the bold outlines and the positioning of the tree in the picture plane from Japanese printmaking, a style he much admired, and created these paintings as a gift for his newborn nephew, Vincent.

*“Normality is a paved road: It’s comfortable to walk,  
but no flowers grow on it.” - Vincent van Gogh*



# TEA WITH THE KING OF SALEM 15

---

Wodka Vodka, Moroccan mint verbena cordial, rosé vermouth



Paulo Coelho spins the magical story of Santiago, an Andalusian shepherd boy who yearns to travel in search of his “treasure”. Along the way he finds the essential wisdom of listening to our hearts, and following our dreams.

Here, aqua vitae meets elements of Santiago’s quest, the places and people that he meets on his journey through Spain and North Africa in a glass of liquid alchemy.

*“They climbed the hill, and they were tired when they reached the top. But there they saw a crystal shop that offered refreshing mint tea. They went in to drink the tea, which was served in beautiful crystal glasses.”*

# MURDER IN THE AFTERNOON 21

---

Pear eau de vie, cassis, strawberry, mint,  
citrus oils, Champagne



A lavish trip through Europe quickly unfolds into a race against time to solve a murder aboard a train. When an avalanche stops the Orient Express dead in its tracks, the world's greatest detective - Hercule Poirot - arrives to interrogate all passengers and search for clues before the killer can strike again.

Agatha Christie had an immense knowledge of potions, pills and poisons, and used them heavily in her works to subdue characters, but also to send the reader off course with their suspicions. Chloral Hydrate was one of her favourites to use - a powerful sedative that carries a subtle taste of pear...

*"The impossible could not have happened, therefore the impossible must be possible in spite of appearances."*

## SIREN'S SONG 15

---

White wine blend, elderflower, mango,  
honey, lemon, thyme



In Book five of Homer's *Odyssey*, the beautiful nymph Calypso attempts to keep the fabled Greek hero Odysseus on her island Ogygia to make him her immortal husband, and enjoy her sensual pleasures forever. According to Homer, Calypso kept Odysseus prisoner by force at Ogygia for seven years. Calypso enchants Odysseus with her singing as she moves to and fro, weaving on her loom and plying him with Ambrosia - the drink of the Gods.

Although seemingly in paradise and heavily under a spell, Odysseus' heart still calls out for his home and his true love Penelope, much to Calypso's dismay.

*"I long for home, long for the sight of home. If any god has marked me out again for shipwreck, my tough heart can undergo it. What hardship have I not long since endured at sea, in battle! Let the trial come."*

# AMBER SPYGLASS 16

---

Singani 63, Calvados, tokaji, apple, marchpane



The *His Dark Materials* series by Philip Pullman has captured the imaginations of people of all ages around the world. Stepping into his not-quite-Earth parallel universe we meet a vivid array of characters that have expanded through books, film and television.

In this similar but different world of Lyra's Oxford, zeppelins and daemons, rich description brings to life the scenery, flora and fauna – not to mention evoking flavours such as marchpane (marzipan), tokay, brantwijn and more.

*“The Tokay was a rich gold colour, and smelled sweet and complicated. Malcolm was seldom tempted by the drinks they sold in the Trout; beer was bitter, and wine was usually sour, and whisky was abominable. But if he could find the bottle later he'd take a sip of this all right, once his father's back was turned...”*

# EYES OF IBAD 19

---

Fortaleza blanco Tequila infused with local chili peppers, mezcal Vago elote, citrus oils and quinine soda



A mythic and emotionally charged hero's journey, *Dune* tells the story of Paul Atreides, a brilliant and gifted young man born into a great destiny beyond his understanding, who must travel to the most dangerous planet in the universe to ensure the future of his family and his people.

Atreides must befriend the local nomadic sand people called the Fremen, whose recreational exposure to of the powerful psychedelic 'spice' gives them their signature bright blue eyes... known as the 'Eyes of Ibad'.

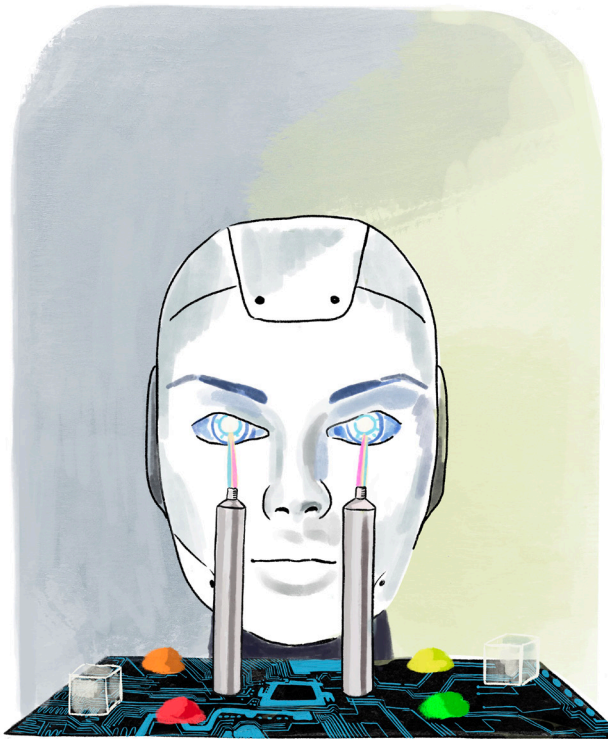
*Dune* is the best-selling science fiction novel of all time, and the entire series is considered to be among the classics of the genre.

# ELECTRIC DREAMS 45

---

Johnnie Walker Black Label, Cynar, mirin, Soto sake, passion fruit, served with a side of flavours – made to share



Philip Kindred Dick wrote 44 novels and 121 short stories in his prolific 30 year career, so it would be hard to pick just one as the inspiration for a drink. Many of his stories have become movies and TV series, and we are surrounded by the numerous futuristic aspects of the world he foreshadowed.

While often dystopian (he predicted pay-walls and targeted advertising), the worlds P.K.D filled with life are rife with unique concepts, colours, social constructs and creative technology.

Imagine what the drinkers in one of his myriad futures might be imbibing, incorporating modern techniques and sustainable nutrient rich ingredients – Add a range of designer flavours to augment your beverage.

*“So books are real to me, too; they link me not just with other minds but with the vision of other minds, what those minds understand and see. I see their worlds as well as I see my own.”*

## STRIKE ME PINK! 50

---

Raspberry tart infused Doorly's 12 years old rum, clarified strawberry, Lady Grey citrus cordial, cream tea – made to share (spoonful of sugar optional)



Way before Julie Andrews became the world's most beloved magical nanny, Mary Poppins had been enchanting the imagination of generations since first appearing in P.L Travers' book in 1934.

The Banks family's adventures with the mysteriously arriving and departing nanny ran right through to 1988, featuring a kaleidoscope of vibrant figures, some regular such as Bert the Screever, or scary governess Miss Andrew, others appearing only for long enough to take part in a particular enchanting escapade. While there are similarities with the movie such as the flying umbrella and carpet bag, M.P in the book has a far less sweet nature, treating the children much more sternly, but still taking them on wonderful flights of fancy before disappearing into the air...

*"He could smell her crackling white apron and the faint flavour of toast that always hung about her so deliciously."*

## E. HEMINGWAY SPECIAL 275

---

1930's Bacardí, 1930's maraschino, fresh lime & grapefruit



Created by Constantino (Constante) Ribalaigua Vert, the legendary head bartender of El Floridita, Havana, Cuba for Ernest Hemingway, after the great man wandered into the bar to use the toilet. When Hemingway tried Floridita's standard frozen Daiquiri, he is quoted as saying, "That's good but I prefer it without sugar and with double rum" - so the Hemingway Special was born.

Here you can try the exact drink that Hemingway made his own - with the original spirits and liqueurs from that exact time period, in a glass from the same era.

*"The clouds were building up now for the trade wind and he looked ahead and saw a flight of wild ducks etching themselves against the sky over the water, then blurring, then etching again and he knew no man was ever alone on the sea."*



# MONTE CRISTO COCKTAIL 360

---

Pre-phylloxera Louis de René Cognac, prohibition-era Mount Vernon rye whiskey, vintage Benedictine, Martini Gentiane, Secretát bitters, Brun-Perod China, J&B Curacao



A prolific writer and well-known bon vivant, Alexandre Dumas was most famous as the author of high-adventure stories, including *The Three Musketeers*, *The Man in the Iron Mask*, *The Black Tulip* and *The Count of Monte Cristo*. He also penned well over 100,000 pages of travel and culinary articles, while his posthumously published magnum opus was *Le Grand Dictionnaire de Cuisine*, a 1,179 page guide to food and cooking.

In *The Count of Monte Cristo*, the wronged protagonist is tutored over years in prison by a fellow inmate who also tells him of a massive treasure he can use to exact his convoluted plan for revenge.

This cocktail is a compilation that would have been de rigeur at the time of Dumas' writing, with a flavour profile as complex as his plots, and based on a Cognac from the same era.

As only 25 of these drinks will ever exist, it is also as unique a treasure as any found on the Ile de Monte Cristo...

*"I have always had more dread of a pen, a bottle of ink, and a sheet of paper than of a sword or pistol."*
